Mayor Talbott congratulated the winners of the election: Mr. K Staggs, Ms. Watson and Mr. Kirby.

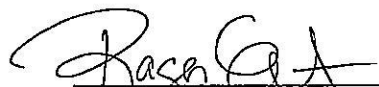
