Regular Village Council Meeting
 April 11, 2011

Present: Mayor Larry Talbott, Harry Tolliver, Betty Kirkpatrick, Michele Watson, Wyndal Staggs, Keith Staggs, Ragan Ernst and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.

Mayor Talbott called this regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then he led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Revenue Status, Appropriation Status and Fund Status reports, and the March, 2011 Bank Reconciliation. Council told Skip to get a street sweeper and sweep the streets.

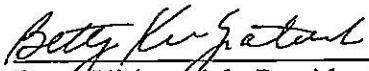
Council discussed the newspapers being left in the town, and end up in the storm sewer.

Skip will mow the lots that don't get taken care of.

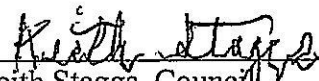

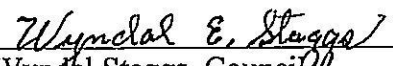
Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adjourn. Ms. Watson seconded it, and it carried, all voting yes.

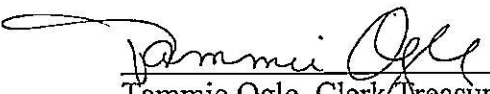
