**Regular Village Council Meeting**  
 February 9, 2009

Present: Mayor Larry Talbott, Betty Kirkpatrick, Michele Watson, Wyndal Staggs, Harry Tolliver, Keith Staggs and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.

Also Present: Cecelia Potts, Chief Canter, Donna Tolliver and Skip Bollinger.

Mayor Talbott called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status reports, and the January, 2009 Bank Reconciliation.
