Regular Village Council Meeting
September 14, 2009**

Present: Mayor Larry Talbott, Jack Shouse, Keith Staggs, Harry Tolliver, Wyndal Staggs, Betty Kirkpatrick, Michele Watson and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.

Mayor Talbott called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status Reports, and the August, 2009 Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, and Mr. Shouse seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

Mayor Talbott recognized Kelly Cole, who presented information on some of the programs offered by the CHIP Grant program. The Council thanked her for her time, and she left brochures.

Mayor Talbott recognized Tammy King, who lives across from the daycare center on Main Street. Customers are blocking her driveway, and some employees are parking there all day. She asked Council to set up a 5 or 10 minute parking limit there. She complained that anytime she has called the Police Department, it takes too long, in her opinion, for them to respond. She also complained because there isn't a Police Officer at the Police Station 24 hours a day. The Council explained to her that the Village does not have the finances to employ a full-time Police Department. The Mayor thanked her for coming, and told her that Council would look into the situation for her.

Mayor Talbott recognized Bob Cantrell, who is building a First Stop gas station/grocery store on the corner next to the Dollar General. He presented plans and photos to the Council and they discussed it with him.
