

Hawesville Village Council
October 2, 1969

Mayor Sawyer called the meeting to order.

Present were: Mayor Sawyer, Debra Ginn, Mooten, Carter Mr. Living and L. Ginn

Motion to amend Ordinance 1969-10 number to Ordinance 1969 10-A
A Ordinance adopting the 1969 311 supplement to the
Ohio Revised Basic Code. Seconded by Elliott Motion carried.

Mr. Living shared his concern for the mailboxes within the
the village limits. Council shared their concerns and did not
want to do anything to jeopardize a postoffice in the village.
Discussion to be tabled.

Mrs. Betty Milpatrick asked the town to sponsor her as police
officer in training. Motion by Moore to sponsor her seconded by
Hanselman Motion carried.

Concern was given on the walkie talkies that Mr. Martin has had
to fix for some time. Mr. Martin said he did not believe that they
met the officers needs. Motion by Stephens to pay Mr. Martin
for the work already done and then to take them to another source
that works on them all the time and have them evaluate them. Seconded
by Jones Motion carried.

Mark Jorosi from the Metro Housing Authority asked us to allow
Metro Housing Authority develop in the Brown County area. Council
list and to his proposal and tabled a discussion till next meeting.

Adopted Ordinance 1969-11, an ordinance establishing salaries
for the village council and the mayor and the village clerk.
This was a second reading.

Mr. Ginn was recognized as a life member. He discussed the
resolutions that were purchased so the board could replace other
lines down 774. Also he discussed the land behind the building that
Mr. Wiley owned and the interest that the board had in the prop-
erty.

A solicitor has been found who is willing to take over the village
at the rate of \$2.00 hour. Council to meet with him before the
next meeting.
