

ORDINANCE #1997 - 22

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MAYOR'S COURT
COMPUTER FUND AND PASSED AS AN
EMERGENCY MEASURE

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has mandated that Mayor's Courts become computerized; and,

WHEREAS, there is authority to establish Mayor's Courts computer funds to pay for the computerization required by the state; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Hamersville is in need of establishing a Mayor's Court computer fund to become computerized.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THAT:

Section 1: The Village of Hamersville hereby establishes a fund to be designated and known as the Mayor's Court Computer Fund.

Section 2: The court costs for each violation in Mayor's Court shall increase \$10.00 per offense, said \$10.00 to be deposited in the Mayor's Court Computer Fund for expenditures from the Mayor's Court Computer Fund to be made for the acquisition and maintenance of computer hardware, software, legal research services, computer space, computer electrical, computer air conditioning, computer furniture, printers, subscription to computer services, computer supplies, training expenses and any and all other related expenditures for compliance with the computerization of Mayor's Court.

Section 3: The fund must be established no later than January, 1998, and therefore the passage of the legislature is done as an emergency to expedite and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the reason that the public health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, require the immediate issuance of said ordinance and the same shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption.
