Regular Village Council Meeting
April 11, 2005

Present: Mayor Wyndal Staggs, Larry Talbott, Harry Tolliver, Keith Staggs, Batty Kirkpatrick, Jack Shouse, Kevin Ogle and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.

Also Present: Police Chief Jim Canter and Cecelia Potts.

Mayor Staggs called this meeting to order and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the Payment Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status reports, as well as the March 31, 2005 Bank Reconciliation. The Council read and approved the Bank reconciliation and the reports. The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the last meeting. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adopt the minutes as presented, and Mr. Tolliver seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to pay all bills as presented. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

The Police Committee has cut the Police Department to 150 hours, with working officers having two hours each for court. Mr. Ogle suggested a Police Levy. The Clerk Treasurer will check with the County Auditor to find out how much a levy would bring and how it would raise property taxes.

Mike will start mowing next week.

Mayor Staggs read Ordinance 2005-6, restricting animals being kept

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outside within the Village to dogs, cats and rabbits for the second time. Mr. Talbott made a motion to adopt this Ordinance, and Mr. Tolliver seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

The Council agreed on May 13, 14 & 15 for Village wide yard sales, as well as August 12, 13 & 14.

The Council members told Mr. Tolliver that the sign he made for Mayors Court looks good.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to suspend the rules for reading an Ordinance three times. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes. Mr. Talbott made a motion to raise Court Costs \$20.00, to \$75.00. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to adopt a Natural Disaster Mitigation plan, Resolution 2005-7. Mr. Staggs seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to proclaim May 5, 2005 National Day of Prayer. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to adjourn. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and it carried, all members voting yes.
