Terry Stephens said he had received a phone call from Mrs. Lorena Blanton regarding a drainage problem. Mayor Bowyer will file a report with the Health Department.

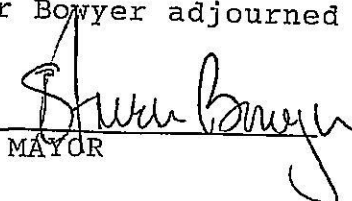

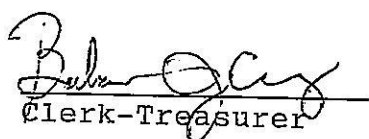
Congress Alley repairs were discussed.
