Regular Village Council Meeting
 March 14, 2016

Present: Mayor Betty Kirkpatrick, Michele Watson, Kathleen Miller, Kim Budke, Ragan Ernst and Fiscal Officer Tammie Ogle.

Also Present: Chief Sutton, David Grimes, Jason LaRue, Brian Durham, Ashley Corcoran, Stephanie Shepherd, Jack Jones, Gordon & Rebecca Ellis.

Mayor Kirkpatrick called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Fiscal Officer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status reports, and the February, 2016 Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Watson made a motion to accept the minutes, and Ms. Budke seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes. All other reports and the Bank Reconciliation were read and approved.

Mayor Kirkpatrick recognized Stephanie Shepherd, who was cited by Captain Riley for parking in the fire zone at the school. She felt he was rude, and her children were afraid. She did not feel Captain Riley did enough to make her children feel better. Council and Mayor Kirkpatrick thanked her for coming in.

Ms. Watson made a motion to pay all bills. Ms. Miller seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Mayor Kirkpatrick read a Jack Jones' letter of resignation from Council.

Chief Sutton gave Jack Shouse 30 days to tear down the storage building on Main Street.

Ms. Watson made a motion to accept the Prisoner Housing Agreement from the Brown County Sheriff. Ms. Budke seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

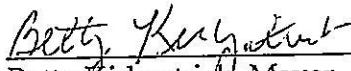
Jason knows someone who would like to pick up brush for mulch. Jason wants a new lawn mower. Council told him to shop around, and bring in some prices. The Council agreed to allow him to buy a new weedeater, not to exceed \$300.

Chief needs to have his classification changed for paperwork purposes only for the 1033 program's new rules. Ms. Watson made a motion to do so, and Ms. Budke seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes. Hamersville is the only school in Brown County that does not have a resource officer. The School Board would reimburse the associated costs. Council told the Chief to look into it.

Ms. Budke made a motion to enter Executive Session. Ms. Watson seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes. Ms. Ernst made a motion to leave Executive Session. Ms. Watson seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Ms. Miller made a motion to hire Jack Jones as Maintenance/Meter Reader, effective immediately, \$10.00 per hour, under 100 hours per month, on one year probation. Ms. Ernst seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes, except Ms. Budke, who abstained.

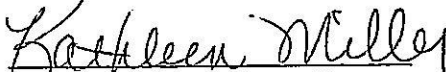
Ms. Ernst made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Watson seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

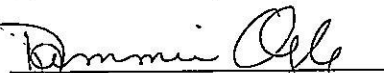
