ORDINANCE NO. 1991- 7

**AN ORDINANCE VACATING PART OF WAYNE AVENUE IN THE VILLAGE OF
HAMERSVILLE**

WHEREAS, A petition was filed with the Council of the Village of Hamersville Ohio to vacate that portion of Wayne Avenue located west of its intersection with Adkins Place, now therefore.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, at least three-fourths of its members concurring:

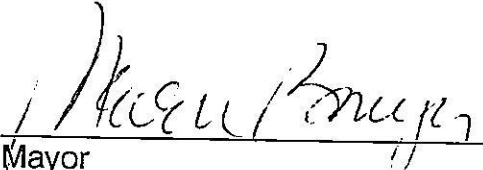
Section 1. There appears to be good cause for the vacation of said street and there will be no detriment to the general interest of the public in said vacation.

Section 2. That the portion of Wayne Avenue lying west of the west boundary of Adkins Place as extended across Wayne Avenue is hereby vacated pursuant to Section 723.04 of the Ohio Revised Code.

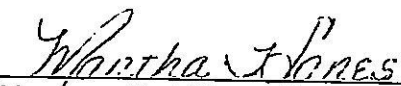
Section 3. Notice of intention to vacate shall not be required by reason that all property owners abutting that part of the street to be vacated have given written consent pursuant to Section 723.06.

Section 4. By vote of Council, the Three Reading Rule is hereby waived and this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure to preserve the health safety and welfare of the habitants of the Village and to insure the safety of pedestrians.
