

VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE
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Regular Village Council Meeting
Monday September 15, 1998 7:00 P.M.

Present: Mayor Duane C. Neu, Clerk Treasurer Martha Hanes and the following members of the village council: Joyce Craig, William, Dean Sr., Donald Sowers, Wyndal Staggs, Bryan Stewart.

Absent Sue Sowers.

Also present: Eunice Ott, Chandra Danner, Dallas Hurt, Randy Goodman, Kenny Green, Betty Kirkpatrick, James Canter, Terry Lawler Edward Martin, and Cecelia Potts

Mayor Neu called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

Mr. Stewart motioned to accept the minutes as presented. Mr. Sowers seconded the motion. All voted YEA. MOTION CARRIED.

Mayor Neu recognized Terry Lawler the grant writer who explained to the council that he was preparing to submit the request for a grant again this year,

Mr. Lawler requested that the council pass RESOLUTION 1998 - 10 the NORTH AVENUE et al RESTRUCTURING PROJECT.

Mr. Staggs motioned and Mr. Dean seconded the motion to adopt RESOLUTION 1998 -10. All voted YEA. MOTION CARRIED.

Mr. Lawler told the council the request was for one hundred thousand and eight dollars. (\$100,008.00) The village match would be eleven thousand and one dollar (\$11,001.00)

Mr. Lawler thanked the council for their time and left the meeting.

Mayor Neu recognized Dallas Hurt from Ross Sinclair who explained to the council that the sewer bond anticipation notes was due to be reissued and that the village needed to have a special council meeting on Monday September 28, 1998 at 7:00 P.M.

Mr. Hurt thanked the council for their time and left the meeting.

Mayor Neu gave the first reading of ORDINANCE 1998-11 ORDINANCE REGARDING DISTURBING OF THE PEACE.

Mr. Dean motioned to accept ordinance 1998-11 with proposed changes. Mr. Stewart seconded the motion. All voted YEA. MOTION CARRIED.

The Mayors Training Classes will be November 14, 1998. Mayor Neu requested that the council sent the Mayor, Vice Mayor and the clerk of mayors court.

Ms. Craig motioned to sent three people to the class. Mr. Stewart seconded the motion. Voting YEA: Craig, Stewart, S. Sowers, D Sowers. Dean, Abstain Staggs. MOTION CARRIED.

Mr. Dean motioned to move Suzanne Elliott from probationary status to part time status and increase her salary from one hundred and twenty five dollars (\$125.00) per month to one hundred and thirty five dollars (\$135.00) per month. Mr. Staggs seconded the motion. All voted YEA. MOTION CARRIED.

Randy Goodman addressed council in regards to the location of the grinder pumps on property he owns in the village. Mr. Goodman stated that he is planning to build an additional home on each of the lots and the grinder pumps will be in the way. Mayor Neu referred this request to the sewer committee to check on and see what needs to be done.

Mr. Dean suggested to the council that the village needs to be looking a putting something in writing regarding subdivisions in village. Mr. Dean suggested that the village define lot sizes, Square footage, Drainage, Street, Street Lights, and water line sizes.

Kenny Green reported that the kids was getting in the recycling bins and throwing the glass out and breaking it and that he was having trouble keeping it cleaned up. Chief Canter said the police have talked to the kids.

Chief Canter reported that the school would like to have the volunteer workers at the school finger printed and that the police department had ordered a finger printing kit so this could be done.

Chief Canter reported that Clinton Fitzpatrick had resigned from the police department however he had not returned his uniforms. Chief Canter will call him and make arrangements for this to be completed.

The proposed lease for the fire department was discussed and Cecelia Potts will work on this and submit a copy to the village council.

ODOT is in the process of repairing and widening SR774 near the intersection on Bethel New Hope Road and the village has sewers lines on the state right of way; since there is a possibility of having to move the sewer lines the village will install two (2) cut off valves to isolate this section of the sewer line.

Mayor Neu called for motion to pay the bills as presented on the voucher.

Ms. Craig motioned and Mr. Stewart seconded the motion to pay the bills. All voted YEA. MOTION CARRIED.

Mayor Neu asked if there is any further business to come before the council?

Hearing none Mr. Dean motioned to adjourn and Mr. Sowers Seconded the motion. All Voted YEA. MOTION CARRIED.

Mayor Neu adjourned the meeting reminding everyone of the next regular meeting to be held on Monday October 12, 1998
