ORDINANCE NO. 1992-8

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF SKATEBOARDS WITHIN THE
VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, at least a majority of its members concurring:

Section 1. Definitions

Skateboard. For the purpose of this ordinance the term "skateboard" shall mean a flat board like devise approximately 18 inches or longer to which is attached 2 or more wheels, the devise being powered by muscular activity.

Skateboarding. For the purpose this ordinance the term "skateboarding " shall mean the riding or use of a skateboard.

Section 2. The riding of skateboards or skateboarding shall be prohibited on all sidewalks and pedestrian walk-ways within the Village of Hamersville.

Section 3. The riding of skateboards or skateboarding shall be prohibited on all State highways located within the Village Hamersville.

Section 4. Whoever shall be found in violation of this ordinance shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the reason that it directly affects the health safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Hamersville.
