Regular Village Council Meeting
 June 8, 2009

Present: Mayor Larry Talbott, Keith Staggs, Harry Tolliver, Jack Shouse, Betty Kirkpatrick, Wyndal Staggs, Michele Watson and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.

Also Present: Jim Canter, Cecelia Potts, Skip Bollinger, Scott McKinney and Duane Neu.

Mayor Talbott called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status reports, and the May, 2009 Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes, and Mr. K Staggs seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes. All other reports and the Bank Reconciliation were read and approved.

Mayor Talbott recognized Scott McKinney, who came to inform Council that he is tearing down a house and replacing it with the JVS house. Council thanked him for his efforts to improve the Village.

Mayor Talbott recognized Mr. Neu, who commented that the flags look good, and the town looks nice and clean.

Mayor Talbott read the letter of resignation from Roy Day from the BPA, due to illness.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to pay all bills as presented. Mr. Shouse seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

The second reading of the Ordinance requesting an Auditor's certificate was held. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept it, and Ms. Watson seconded it. Roll call vote resulted as follows:

Mayor Talbott broke the tie with a yes vote.

Mr. W Staggs had a complaint about a tree on the corner of Lucas and St. Rt. 125 blocking line of sight for drivers coming out of Lucas Road.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to suspend reading an Ordinance three times, and Mr. K Staggs seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes. Mr. W Staggs made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2009-08, regulating yard sales in the Village, and declaring an emergency. Mr. Tolliver seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

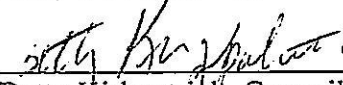
The Brown County Sheriff has sent another contract to replace the earlier one, this one raising prisoner housing to \$50.00 per night. Mr. K Staggs made a motion to accept it, and Mr. Shouse seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

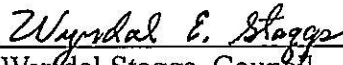

Mr. W Staggs and Mr. K Staggs both objected strenuously to the officer suggested by the chief, due to past issues when he was on the Police Department. Chief Canter rescinded his request. Mr. W Staggs complained about the sale of illegal drugs in town. Council discussed it.

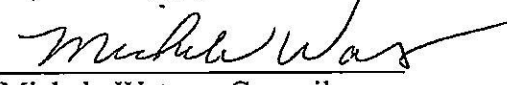

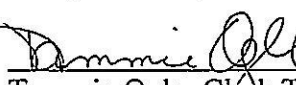
