Regular Village Council Meeting
April 12, 2004

Present: Mayor Wyndal Staggs, Larry Talbott, Betty Kirkpatrick, Harry Tolliver, Kevin Ogle, Eric Johnson and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle. Also Present: Pat Hodges, Jim and Sharon Walker and Perry Ogden, representing the HJSA, Lonny Riley, Jim Meranda, Chief Jim Canter, Ben Graham, Jared Riley, Keith Staggs, Leonard Wilson and Wayne Boblitt.

Mr. Staggs called this regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then Led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status Report, and Appropriation and Revenue Status Reports. Mr. Ogle made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded it. The motion carried, all members voting yes. The Council approved the March, 2004 Bank Reconciliation.

Mr. Staggs recognized Jim Meranda, who wants to put a double wide on his lot, and then tear his house down after he moves in. The Council approved these plans.

Mr. Staggs recognized Leonard Wilson of 271 West Main St., who came to complain about the residents at 261 West Main pumping their washing machine water into the ditch between the two properties. He claims to have a drainage problem because the natural ditch behind the homes is blocked. The neighbor blocking the ditch agreed to clean it out. The Council will try to locate the owner of 261 West Main to get them hooked into the sewer.

Mr. Staggs recognized the group from the Sports Association, and County Commissioner Ogden spoke. The County has approximately \$180,000 for Community programs in the form of CDBG grants. He has been working with Sharon Walker to try to get a grant for the park. The Village would have to apply for the grant. Mrs. Walker is willing to do the work if the Village will agree. Mr. Ogle made a motion to allow them to do so, and Mr. Talbott seconded it. The motion carried, all members voting yes. The Council thanked them for their dedication to the community.

Mr. Tolliver brought up the unsafe buildings in town. We now have a copy of the building code Mt. Orab uses. We will find out how to make it work for us.

Mr. Staggs recognized Chief Canter. The qualifications for the Police Officers is changing. The instructor suggested that the officers practice two or three times for the test. This will cost about \$1,000. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to allow them to do so. Mr. Tolliver seconded the motion, and it carried, all members voting yes. The blue cruiser's repairs and updates are almost finished.
