Beggar's night will be October 30th from 6:00 to 7:30 p.m.

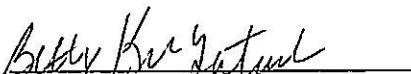
We have two different residents holding yard sales without permits and longer than permits allow. The Police Department will cite them to court.

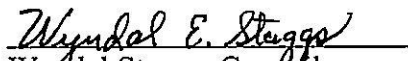
October 13, 2008, cont'd.

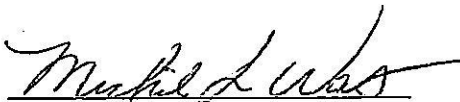

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adjourn, and Mr. Tolliver seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

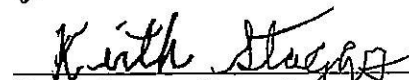

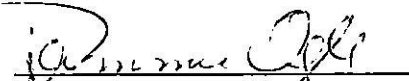
