 March 10, 2008

Mayor Talbott asked Ms. Potts to begin the paperwork to change the Clerk Treasurer position to a Fiscal Officer.

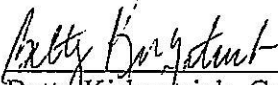

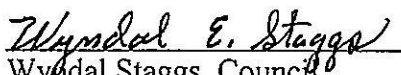
All Council Employees will give their time sheets to the Mayor for approval before they are processed.

Wyndal had complaints about the water at Walnut & Bank. A new culvert needs to be installed. Mayor Talbott will talk to the property owner.

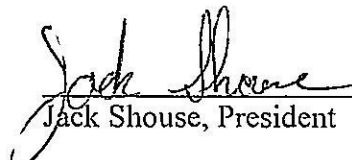
Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adjourn, and Mr. Shouse seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

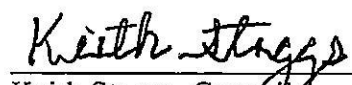

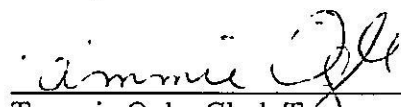
