Regular Meeting June 15, 1992

Present: President Jesse Nestor, Mack Hanes, Edward Martin,
Clenk Treasurer Martha Hanes.

Also Present: Mayor Steven Bowyer, Kay Elliott, Lynn Dunn,
Colby Saylor and John Van Harlingen.

President Nestor called the meeting to order and asked
for a motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as
presented. Mr. Hanes made a motion to accept the minutes as
presented seconded by Mr. Martin. Voteing: Hanes: YEA, Martin: YEA.
Voteing: Nay, None. **MOTION CARRIED.**

President Nestor then asked for a motion to pay the bills as
presented; Mr. Martin motioned seconded by Mr. Hanes to pay the bills
as presented. Voteing: Martin: YEA, Hanes: YEA. Voteing Nay: None.
MOTION CARRIED.

John Van Harlingen discussed the five year plan with the
Board; the water tower and what the Board could expect in
future repairs and maintenance. Mr. Van Harlingen stated that
the water tower should be welded and repainted every five or
six years.

The Clerk to send a letter to Georgetown asking why the
Village was not notified that the water was going to be shut off.

It was reported that the vandals had turned the fire
hydrant on, on Mobile Acres Dr. and Mr. Saylor had to go out and
turn it off.

Mayor Bowyer suggested that the Board watch their Electric
Fund very closely because the fund is extremely low and the new
rates have not started yet. All bills for the Electric fund will
be monitored closely.

Mr. Martin made a motion to proceed with the new water line
on Liming Lake Road., Seconded by Mr. Hanes. Voteing: Martin: YEA,
Hanes: YEA, Voteing: Nay, None. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Lynn Dunn reported on the Electric Dept. and stated that
the lines are all in good repair, but the bucket truck needs
some repair work but it can wait until the Electric fund is
in better condition.

Kay Elliott reported on the bill for the utilities
and the amount of outstanding bills. Kay also reported on the
requests for new Water and Electric Service.

Mr. Colby Saylor reported on the water Dept. and stated
that he thinks there is a water leak on Liming Van Thompson Rd,
but Mr. Conley says there is no leak. Mr. Conley to be asked to
check this area again.

President Nestor asked if there was any further business
to come before the Board at this time; hearing none Martin motioned
to adjourn seconded by Hanes. Voteing: Martin: YEA, Hanes: YEA.

Voting: Nay None. MOTION CARRIED.

President Nesten adjourned the meeting reminding every one the next meeting will be Monday July 20, 1992 at 7:00P.M.
