Regular Village Council Meeting
October 11, 2004

Present: Mayor Wyndal Staggs, Keith Staggs, Larry Talbott, Betty Kirkpatrick, Kevin Ogle and Harry Tolliver

Mayor Staggs called this regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the September, 2004 Bank Reconciliation, which the members read and accepted. The Clerk Treasurer also presented the Minutes of the previous meeting, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status reports. Mr. Ogle made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Mayor Staggs recognized Judy Harris, who is wanting to establish a business in town. She will be selling business services. The Council told her that there are no special requirements, except that her sign can not block line of sight of traffic. Ms. Harris thanked Council.

Mayor Staggs then recognized Sesame Fultz and William Preston. They live across from the Feed Mill and want to tear down their house to put in a mobile home. The Council told them to go to the Administration Building in Georgetown and get a copy of their plat, then bring it back to Council to discuss it.

Mayor Staggs recognized the various visitors running for political office.

The Board of Public Affairs has recommended to Council that they would like to give all electric customers a 10% discount on their electric bills due December 15, 2004, as a Christmas Gift. Mr. Talbott made a motion to do so, and Mr. Ogle seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adjourn, and Mr. Ogle seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.
