Regular Village Council Meeting
 March 10, 2014

Present: Mayor Betty Kirkpatrick, John Kirby, Kathleen Miller, Kim Budke and Fiscal Officer Tammie Ogle.

Mayor Kirkpatrick called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Fiscal Officer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status reports, and the February, 2014 Bank Reconciliation. Mr. Kirby made a motion to accept the minutes, and Ms. Budke seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes. All other reports and the Bank Reconciliation were read and approved.

The Sheriff's Office did not respond to a domestic call in the Village, and Brandon had to come in from an hour away.

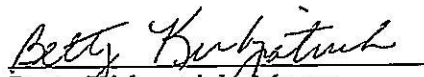

He told Council that Ohio Law says that it is up to the Police Chief to decide what to do with personnel and equipment. Mr. Kirby told him that he does not like him storing his personal vehicle in our garage. The Police Officers will have training in July and September.

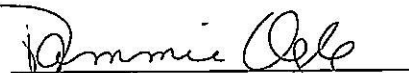
Mr. Kirby made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Budke seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.
