Regular Village Council Meeting
October 13, 2003

Present: Larry Talbott, Eric Johnson, Kevin Ogle, Betty Kirkpatrick and Harry Tolliver.

Mr. Talbott presided over this meeting due to the illness of Mr. Staggs. Mr. Talbott called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer opened the snow removal bid we received. It was from Cornett's Lawn and Garden for \$50.00 per hour. Mr. Ogle made a motion to table this discussion until the next meeting. He feels that we can keep the roads clear of snow ourselves. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to accept the minutes of the previous month's meetings. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and it carried, all members voting yes.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to add the Mayor's Court Clerk's duties to those of our Billing Clerk, Kay Elliott, at the same pay as Suzanne Madden, retroactive to October 1, 2003. Mr. Johnson seconded the motion, and it carried, all members voting yes.

The Clerk Treasurer was instructed to contact our insurance carrier concerning the damage to the Police Cruiser. We will have Barry's Chevrolet in West Union do the repairs, as they are the lowest quote.

Kenny will get insecticide from the Feed Mill for the bagworms on the tree outside this office.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to renew the maintenance agreement for the emergency siren with the company recommended by the County Commissioners. Mr. Tolliver seconded the motion, and it carried with all members voting yes, except Mr. Ogle, who abstained.

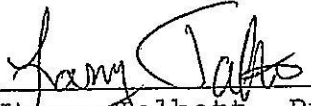

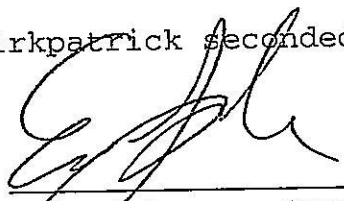
Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to pay all bills, and Mr. Ogle seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes.
