

ORDINANCE # 2022-05

**AN ORDINANCE REGARDING REFUNDS OF MAYOR'S COURT OVERPAYMENTS
AND DECLARING THE SAME AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Defendants in the Village of Hamersville's Mayor's Court routinely make an overpayment of their fines and costs;

WHEREAS, The Mayor's Court Clerk is in need of instruction on how to properly account for these funds:

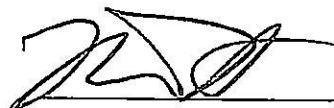
BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, State of Ohio, three-fourths of the members thereof concurring:

Section 1. Overpayments made by Village of Hamersville Mayor's Court Defendants of greater than \$5.00 shall be refunded to the Defendant. Checks for said refunds shall be voided after 365 days. Funds from these uncashed checks shall be transferred to the general fund.

Section 2. Overpayments made by Village of Hamersville Mayor's Court Defendants of less than \$5.00 shall be deposited into the Village of Hamersville's General Fund.

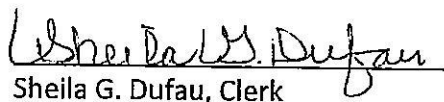
Section 3. That the ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the purpose of refunding or depositing overpayments for the Village of Hamersville's Mayor's Court Defendants. And this ordinance shall be in full force and effective immediately upon its adoption.
