

**VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
January 3, 1995 - 7:00P.M.**

PRESENT: Mayor Steve Bowyer, Jesse Nester, Duane Neu, James Johnston, Sue Sowers, Wyndal Staggs, Martha Hanes, Clerk-Treasurer Sherri Lewis

ALSO PRESENT: Chief of Police James Canter, BPA President Mack Hanes, Bruce Brandstetter, Brown County Press Eunice Ott, Tim Sharp, Brandon Sharp, James Bishop, Mae Bishop, Beth Bishop.

Mayor Bowyer Called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m. and asked if there were any corrections or additions to the minutes of December 5, 1994.

Noted Corrections: Strike Bowyer from votes.

Neu motioned to accept minutes with the exceptions of strikes, Hanes seconded the motion. **VOTING: YEA:** Nester, Neu, Johnston, Sowers, Staggs, Hanes. **NAY:** None **MOTION CARRIED.**

Hanes motioned to accept minutes of December 29, 1994 with the exceptions of strikes, Neu seconded the motion. **VOTING: YEA:** Nester, Neu, Johnston, Sowers, Staggs, Hanes. **NAY:** None. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Presentation of Plaque's: Mr. & Mrs. Bishop 1st place, Mr. Sharp 2nd place.

Bruce Brandstetter discussed meeting with Mayor Bowyer regarding the sewer project. He then handed out revised sewer project prices he had come up with, then explained the difference's between them and how he came up with the new figures. Bruce explained the difference of the options.

Johnston commented on option 4 and how it may create problems if the village were to extend the sewer project outside the corporation limit and charge a higher price for the service. Johnston also questioned who would pay for taps if not being tapped into at time of project construction. (i.e. vacant lots, building lots).

Staggs questioned where Bruce got his number of people from. Mayor Bowyer answered that the number was given by Kay Elliott. Staggs felt that the numbers still needed work.

Johnston asked if the sewer charge was by water usage or by sewer meter usage. Bruce felt by water would be better. Staggs commented that some people water gardens or fill pools and that it would be unfair to charge for water not going thru sewage treatment.

Hanes motioned to allow street committee to hire for snow removal if necessary until someone could be contracted. Nester seconded the motion. VOTING: YEA: Sowers, Nester, Hanes, Bowyer. NAY: None. ABSTAINED: Staggs, Johnston, Neu. MOTION CARRIED.

Johnston motioned to recess the meeting. Hanes seconded the motion. VOTING: YEA: Nester, Neu, Johnston, Sowers, Staggs, Hanes. NAY: None. MOTION CARRIED.
