RESOLUTION NO: 2011- 07

RESOLUTION FOR ELECTION ON RENEWAL TAX LEVY EXCEEDING
TEN-MILL LIMITATION
PASSED AS AN EMERGENCY

The Council of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, met in regular session on the 8th day of August, 2011 with the following members present:

Keith Staggs Wyndal Staggs Betty Kirkpatrick
Harry Tolliver Ragan Ernst Michele Watson

Council person Kirkpatrick moved the adoption of the following resolution:

RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, by a majority vote:

1. The amount of taxes that may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide for the necessary requirements of the Village of Hamersville and it is necessary to levy a tax exceeding that limitation for the purpose of providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications, other equipment, buildings, and sites for such buildings used directly in the operation of a police department, or the payment of salaries of permanent police personnel, including the payment of the police officer employers' contribution required under section 742.33 of the Revised Code, of the subdivision pursuant to Section 5705.19(j) of the Ohio Revised Code.
2. The renewal levy will constitute a tax of 2.0 mills for each dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.20 for each \$100.00 of valuation.
3. The renewal levy shall remain in effect for five (5) years for the tax years, beginning 2011 with first collection in 20 12.

4. The Clerk of the Village of Hamersville shall certify a copy of this resolution to the Board of Elections of Brown County not later than August 10, 2011 and request the Board to provide for notice of the election on November 8, 2011, as required by law.

CERTIFICATE OF COUNTY AUDITOR

PURSUANT TO R.C. 5705.20 AUG -9 AM 8:50

The County Auditor of Brown County, Ohio, does hereby certify the following:

1. On July 8, 2011 the taxing authority of the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio certified a copy of its resolution or ordinance adopted May 9, 2011 requesting the county auditor to certify the current tax valuation and the amount of the revenue that would be produced by two (2.0) mills, to levy a tax outside the ten-mill limitation for all purposes of police protection pursuant to Section 5705.19 of the Ohio Revised Code, to be placed on the November 8, 2011 election.
2. The levy type is renewal.
3. The estimated property tax revenue that will be produced by the stated millage, assuming the tax valuation of the county remains constant throughout the life of the levy, is calculated to be \$9,000.00.
4. The total tax valuation of the county used in calculating the estimated property tax revenue rate is \$5,489,440.00.
5. If passed, first collection of this tax levy will commence January 2012.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. "Total tax valuation" includes the taxable value of all real, personal, and public utility property in the subdivision, which are on the tax lists that were most recently certified for collection. If the subdivision is located in more than one county, the home county auditor (where the greatest taxable value of the subdivision is located) shall obtain the assistance of the other county auditors to establish the total tax valuation of the subdivision.
2. "Levy type" includes additional, renewal, renewal with an increase, renewal with a decrease, replacement, replacement with an increase, and replacement with a decrease levies.
