

ORDINANCE No. 1988-2

AN ORDINANCE ENTERING INTO A CONTRACT
WITH RUMPKE WASTE, INC, FOR THE COLLECTION
AND DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE AND REFUSE IN THE VILLAGE OF
HAMERSVILLE, OHIO, AND ESTABLISHING THE RATES AND
CHARGES AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, THE Village has heretofore ordained in
Ordinance No. 1987-7, for the mandatory pick-up and disposal
of garbage and waste material in the Village of Hamersville
by residences and business and commercial establishments; and

WHEREAS, the Village has heretofore advertised for
bids for the service and The Rumpke Waste, Inc., submitted a
bid of \$24,300.00, for a three year term, beginning January 1,
1988, through December 31, 1990, and

Whereas, the Village is desirous for awarding the
contract for pick-up and disposal of garbage and refuse in the
Village of Hamersville, to Rumpke Waste, Inc., and authorize the
Mayor and Clerk to execute a contract for the same.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of
Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) or more of
all members concurring as follows:

SECTION I. The Village of Hamersville enter into a
contract with Rumpke Waste, Inc. for the collection and
disposal of garbage and refuse in the Village of Hamersville,
for a three year period beginning January 1, 1988, through
December 31, 1990, selling for the payment of \$24,300.00, to be
billed monthly, said contract to be in accordance with the head
of Rumpke Waste, Inc., the instructions to bidders and the

specifications attached to the bid. The Mayor and Clerk are authorized to sign an agreement.

SECTION II. Effective with the February 1 billing for utility services to the customers of the Village of Hamersville the rates and charges for garbage and trash collection in the Village, shall be \$3.25, per month to all residences and all business and commercial establishments.

SECTION III. Collection of garbage and refuse shall be made from the following customers:

1. All Single family residences.
2. All multiple family residences of less than ten (10) units per building.
3. All multiple family residences of ten (10) units or more who do not choose private dumpster service.
4. All business and commercial establishments who do not use more than eight (8) 35 gallon can weighing 65 pounds or less or 8 normal size plastic bags.
5. All local commercial establishments which exceed this amount shall be contacted regarding private contracts.

SECTION IV. The term "Waste Material" shall include all solid refuse or putrescible wastes originating from the use of residential property and commercial establishments, situated in the corporate limits of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, and more specifically being identified in the following categories:

RESIDENTIAL

(a) Any material (other than dirt, rocks, concrete, construction material or similar matter, capable of being enclosed in metal or plastic containers) not larger than 35

gallons capacity and with a gross weight of not more than 65 pounds.

(b) Brush tied in small bundles, not more than 18 inches in diameter and not to exceed five (5) feet in length. (Large limbs and trees not being acceptable.)

(c) Wooden boxes and paper boxes either whole or broken down and tied in small bundles.

(d) Newspapers and magazines, not placed in cans, tied in small bundles.

(e) Cold ashes placed in a separate container.

(f) Garbage as defined as organic waste of animal, fish, fruit or vegetable matter arising from or attendant to the storage, dealing in, preparation or cooking of food for human consumption.

(g) Grass clippings and leaf rakings when properly bagged or boxed and identified as per Village requirements.

(h) Collection shall be once per week at the curb or right of way line, or at rear of property where applicable.

SECTION V. COMMERCIAL

(a) Contractor shall collect and remove trash and waste from all commercial establishments within the area aforementioned, which use less than eight (8) 35 gallon cans weighing 65 pounds or less or eight (8) normal size plastic bags.

(b) Dumpster service to be provided as presently practiced by Village Crews, including frequency of pickk-up, etc.

(c) Dumpster service to be readily available to any new user, price of which to be shown on bidder's proposal.

(d) Contractor shall offer collection and removal service to all other commercial establishments on an individual contract basis.

VILLAGE

(a) Contractor shall furnish and service 6 yd. containers as needed

(b) Contractor shall empty all Town trash containers.

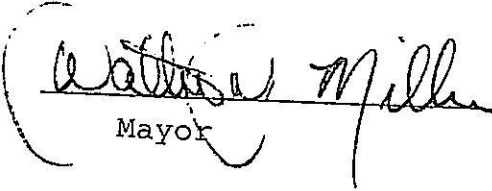
SECTION VI. Residents and Commercial establishments of the Village of Hamersville will be charged with the responsibility that all garbage will be drained, wrapped in paper, and placed in metal or plastic water tight containers with tight lids or wired ends, not to exceed 35 gallons capacity and not more than 65 pounds in weight. Rubbish will be placed in similar cans and garbage and rubbish need not be separated. Brush must be tied in small bundles not to exceed 18 inches in diameter and not to exceed five (5) feet in length. (Large limbs or trees will not be accepted.) Paper boxes will be broken down and tied in bundles. Grass clippings, and leaves must be bagged or boxed. Newspaper and magazines shall be tied in bundles. Ashes will be collected and placed in separate containers with adequate covers. All containers will be placed at the curb or edge of street right of way.

SECTION VII. In general, the contractor shall pick up everything set out by the resident including appliances and large furniture, (refrigerators, dishwashers, washers, dryers, carpet, mattresses, and other similar items). The collector must remove all materials and contents set out by residents and avoid spilling waste material and clean up the collection area if the waste is spilled. Any trash cans exceeding 35 gallons will be picked up and themselves treated as trash. All Christmas trees shall be picked up.

SECTION VIII. Collections shall be made at least once a week and between the hours of 5:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M.

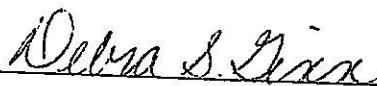
Collections shall be made on all holidays.

SECTION IX. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Hamersville, and more particularly for the reason that it is necessary that garbage and refuse be collected and disposed of and that a proper charge be assessed and collected therefor in order for the municipal finances of the Village to remain sound and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
