

ORDINANCE NO. 1978-6

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF
AIR GUNS AND SIMILAR DEVICES WITHIN
THE CONFINES OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville,
Brown County, Ohio, three-fourth (3/4) of all members thereof
concurring as follows:

SECTION 1. No person shall shoot, force, or throw by means
of an air gun or other arm or implement, a lead, iron or other
hard substance;

(A) upon, across or onto a public street, alley, lane
or other public place

(B) upon, across or onto the lands of another

(C) from a motor vehicle

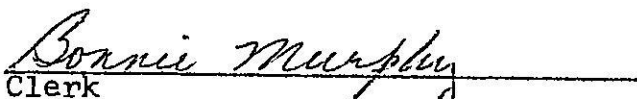
SECTION 2. Whoever violates SECTION ONE of this ordinance
shall be fined a maximum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) on the first
offense and a maximum of Ninety-five Dollars (\$95.00) for the
second and each offense thereafter.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of
the public peace, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the
Village of Hamersville, Ohio, in order to reduce the potential
for vandalism and other damage to the personal ^{and real} property of the
inhabitants of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, and for the
further reason that there have been numerous incidents within the
Village of Hamersville whereby windows have been broken by air
guns, BB guns or similar devices and this Ordinance shall take
effect immediately upon its passage.
