Regular Village Council Meeting
 November 8, 2010

Mayor Talbott called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status reports, and the October, 2010 Bank Reconciliation. 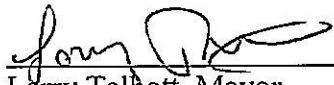

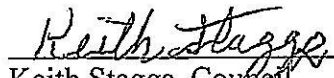
Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adjourn. Mr. K Staggs seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

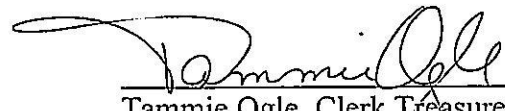
