Regular Village Council Meeting
July 11, 2005

Mayor Staggs called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

We need to look for alternative housing for prisoners. The jail is still full.

The Police Department painted the lines on Main Street this month.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.
