Regular Village Council Meeting
 October 11, 2010

Present: Mayor Larry Talbott, Keith Staggs, Harry Tolliver, Wyndal Staggs, Ragan Ernst, Betty Kirkpatrick, Michele Watson and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.

Also Present: Chief Canter, Donna Tolliver, Suzanne Madden, Wayne Johnson, Skip Bollinger and Cecelia Potts.

Mayor Talbott called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status, and Appropriation Status reports, and the September, 2010 Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, and Ms. Ernst seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes. All other reports and the Bank Reconciliation were read and approved.

Mayor Talbott recognized Wayne Johnson, who came to discuss the trailer that his Church wants to move in to replace an older one. Mr. W. and K. Staggs went and looked at the newer one, and recommend to allow the replacement. The Council agreed. He asked about the sewer pump in the lot where they want to expand their parking. Ms. Potts told him that the customer would be responsible for all costs associated with taking it out, and that they would have to pay a new hook-up fee if they ever wanted to put it in again. He thanked Council.

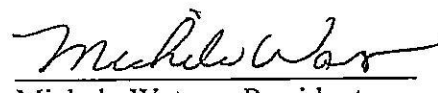
Mayor Talbott is looking for a Grant to build a new Police /Mayor's Court Building.

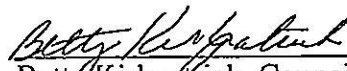

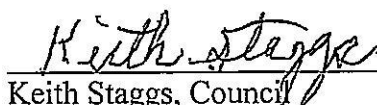
Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adjourn, Ms. Ernst seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

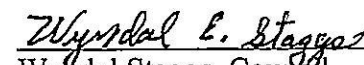

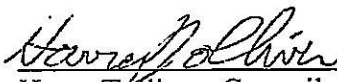

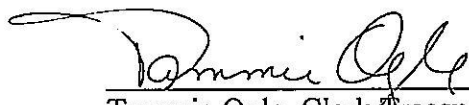
