Regular Board Meeting
Monday July 19, 1993 7:00 P.M.

Present: Board of Public Affairs Members; Mack Hanes President, William Dean Sr. and Edward Martin. Martha Hanes Clerk Treasurer.

Also Present: Mayor Steven Bowyer, Ms. Kay Elliott, Mr. Lynn Dunn and Mr. Colby Saylor.

The meeting was called to order by the President Mack Hanes who asked for a motion to accept the minutes of their previous meeting as presented; Mr. Dean motioned to accept the minutes with a spelling correction. Seconded by Mr. Martin voted and carried.

Mr. Hanes then asked for a motion to pay the bills as presented. Mr. Dean motioned seconded by Mr. Martin to pay the bills Voted and Carried.

There was a discussion on why R and B Agricultural was used to repair the utility truck and it was explained that they offered the best price and the quickest service on the work needed to be done.

Mr. Dunn reported that he had not had time to order the poles and cross arms for the electric department; however he would take care of this at once.

Mr. Dunn discussed the electric line that had been down on Fite Ave. and reported that he had set a new pole on High and Walnut Streets.

It was also reported that there was electric service on Wayne Ave. and Lynn Dunn would need to set some new poles and anchors before the electric could be extended to Adkins Place.

Mr. Saylor reported that the Valve on Lucas Road had been checked and it will be repaired A.S.A.P.

Mr. Roger Adkins will be putting in a water Main on Adkins Place and Mr. Adkins was told that Mr. Rose should check this line before it is covered up.

Mr. Adkins will also be putting in a 4 inch line to be used in the future for sewers if needed.

Mayor Bowyer asked the Board if the Village Council could have a copy of their monthly balances.

Mr. Paul Rose entered the meeting at 7:45 P.M. and discussed the Flush hydrant and the gate valve on Lucas Road.

Kay Elliott reported that Charlie McKinney had applied for a new water tap on State Route 774 South and had paid his fee.

Mr. Dean motioned seconded by Mr. Hanes to replace the

place a flush hydrant and gate valve on Lucas road an to repair the small leak on Liming Van Thompson and to move and replace the water meter and hook the customer back up on Mobile Acres Drive. Voted and Carried.

Mayor Bowyer asked the Board if the Village could move the wall so there would be room for the old police cruiser in the building where the utility truck is stored. The Board replied that they had no problem with this suggestion.

Kay Elliott asked for permission to purchase a new calculator. Mr. Dean Motioned seconded by Mr. Hanes voted and carried.

Mr. Hanes asked if there was any further business to come before the board; hearing none Mr. Dean motioned to adjourn seconded by Mr. Martin Voted and Carried.

Mr. Hanes adjourned the meeting reminding everyone that the next regular meeting would be Monday August 16, 1993 at 7:00 P.M.
