

HAMERSVILLE COUNCIL MEETING
 July 24, 1988, 5:00 p.m.
 Hamersville Community Building

Meeting called to order by Mayor Miller.

Present were: Terry Stephens, Jim Walker, Steve Fowyer,
 Chuck Moore, and Pat Hanselman.
 Also present were: Chief Canter and Stan Purdy.

Pat Hanselman appointed clerk protemp due to absence of
 clerk Ginn. Budget for 1989 was presented by Mayor.

Discussion on the pros and cons of pit bull ordinance. State
 Statue provides guidelines for ownership of pit bulldogs.
 Owner must carry 50,000.00 liability insurance as well as keep
 his dog fenced in. After discussion, Council decided to try to
 enforce state statute through prosecutor rather than adopting
 ordinance at this time.

Ordinance requiring mowing of properties monthly May-October
 presented by Purdy. After review by council some wording was
 felt in need of change and additional information as to fines
 to be imposed. Purdy to change as needed and return for approval.

Discussion on junk cars at south corner of S.R. 774 and Wooster.
 Letter to be sent notifying of Ordinance # 258 in an effort to
 get cars moved.

Discussion opened on current budget situation specifically
 general fund. Council agreed to closely monitor general fund
 balance over the next few months and make adjustments as
 needed.

Regular monthly meeting not to be held August 1 but scheduled
 for August 8, 1988 at 7:00 p.m.

Motion to adjourn by Stephens seconded by Fowyer. Motion carried.
