Regular Village Council Meeting
 May 11, 2009

Present: Mayor Larry Talbott, Harry Tolliver, Michele Watson, Keith Staggs, Wyndal Staggs, Jack Shouse, Betty Kirkpatrick and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.

Mayor Talbott called this regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Revenue Status, Appropriation Status and Fund Status reports, and the April, 2009 Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, and Mr. Shouse seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes. All other reports and the Bank Reconciliation were read and approved.

Mayor Talbott read Ordinance 2009-07, a 2 mil levy, for the third time. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adopt it, and Mr. Shouse seconded it. Roll call vote resulted as follows:

Mayor Talbott broke the tie with a yes vote.

The ditching is done. Ronnie Blair did a good job.

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The Maintenance Department needs a new lawn mower. Mr. W Staggs made a motion to purchase a new walk-behind mower, price not to exceed \$4,000.00. Mr. K Staggs seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Mr. Shouse made a motion to give Jared a raise of \$1.00 per hour, effective May 1. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to give Ben a raise of \$.50 per hour, effective May 1. Ms. Watson seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Mr. W Staggs complained about the town not being mowed yet. Chief Canter reminded him that the Ordinance allows 30 days, beginning May 1. Chief is working on the mowing and clean-up letters.

Maintenance will do street sweeping on May 21.

Skip will put up flags on May 22nd. He will also order some new stop signs.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adjourn. Mr. Tolliver seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.
