Regular Village Council Meeting
May 10, 2010

Present: Mayor Larry Talbott, Keith Staggs, Harry Tolliver, Ragan Ernst, Betty Kirkpatrick, Michele Watson and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.

Also Present: Edna Pride, Wayne Johnson, Harlan Moore, Donna Tolliver, Skip Bollinger, Chirf Canter, Suzanne Madden and Cecelia Potts.

Mayor Talbott called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status reports, and the April, 2010 Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes, and Mr. Staggs seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes. All other reports, as well as the Bank Reconciliation, were read and approved.

Mayor Talbott recognized Edna Pride, who came to ask whose responsibility it is to have the camper moved that is blocking the alley leading to her property. Ms. Potts informed her that it is the Village's responsibility to have it moved. The Village also has the option to vacate the alley. Mayor Talbott told her that it will be taken care of as soon as possible.

Mayor Talbott recognized Wayne Johnson, who is the Pastor of the Church on the corner of Sisterville and Walnut. He came to discuss a water run-off problem they are having. Council told him that the culvert there is his responsibility. They will fix it, and asked if they could tie in some downspouts as well. They also asked about putting in metal stakes to block the neighbors tearing up the yare. Ms. Potts told him that they cannot put anything in the "easement area".

Mayor Talbott recognized Harlan Moore, who is a Trustee at Mt. Nebo Methodist Church, and he asked if the Church could put a permanent sign within the corporation limits. When the Council asked where he wants to put it, he told them he would like to put it at the St. Rt. 125/St. Rt. 774 intersection. Council told him that is fine. As long as it does not block line of sight.

Mayor Talbott remarked that Mr. K Staggs has been working diligently on the houses that Council wants demolished using the NSP program through the county. There are several already slated for removal, and thanks to another round of money, Mr. K Staggs has some ideas to work on. Mayor Talbott thanked him for his work.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to pay all bills, and Mr. Staggs seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

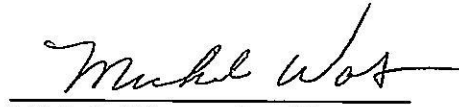
The culvert at Bank & Wooster has been replaced.

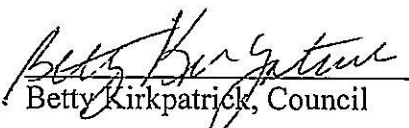

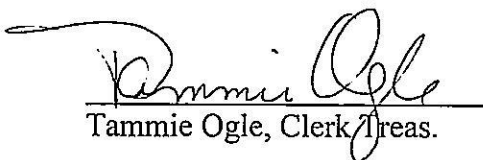
