

ORDINANCE # 2021-D7

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ESTABLISHING COSTS IN MAYOR'S COURT
AND DECLARING THE SAME AN EMERGENCY**

Whereas, the Village of Hamersville Mayor's Court needs to collect Court Costs for each case in order to keep the Court in operation:

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, State of Ohio, three-fourths of the members thereof concurring:

Section 1. Each Defendant found guilty in Mayor's Court shall be assessed Court costs in an amount of \$125.00.

Section 2. The Mayor's Court Clerk shall assess an additional Court Cost to each Defendant in each case of \$ 100.00 when a bench warrant is issued.

Section 3. The Mayor's Court Clerk shall assess an additional Court Cost to each Defendant in each case of \$ 125.00 when a license suspension is issued.

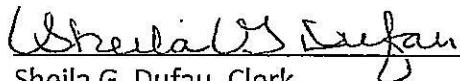
Section 4. That because of the cost of the operation of the mayor's Court in the Village of Hamersville, Ohio and the increased volume of cases that is heard by the Mayor's Court of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio that this is an emergency and is necessary for the orderly administration of justice in the Village this ordinance shall therefore be declared an emergency and shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
