

RESOLUTION 225

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A BID FOR THE
PURCHASE OF A NEW POLICE CRUISER

Be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Hamersville,
Brown County, Ohio, three-fourths or more of all members
thereto
elected/concurring, as follows:

Section 1. Whereas, Jimmy Parsons Ford of 113-117 Sutton
Street, Maysville, Kentucky, submitted a bid to the Village of
Hamersville, Ohio, in accordance with the advertising for bids
published in the News Democrat of Georgetown, Ohio, in which he
agreed to sell the Village of Hamersville, Ohio a 1966 Ford, 4
Door Sedan police cruiser, color-Raven Black, Base 289 2V,
Police Package, Riveted Brakes, Cruiser 390 4V, Vinyl Trim, etc.
all to the satisfaction of the Village.

Section 2. And Whereas, Jimmy Parsons Ford was the only
bid submitted and the Council feels that said bid is a good low
bid and desires to accept the same.

Section 3. Now Therefore, be it resolved that the Village
of Hamersville, Ohio accept the bid of Jimmy Parsons Ford for
the furnishing of the above police cruiser calling for the total
price to be Two Thousand One Hundred Thirty One Dollars
(\$2,131.00) and that the Village proceed to complete the purchase
hereof.

Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund
of said Village the sum of Two Thousand One Hundred Thirty One
Dollars (\$2,131.00) as the same becomes available in order to
make payment for said police cruiser.

Section 5. This resolution shall be effective immediately
upon its passage.
