Mr. Wooten to put a stop sign at Sisterville & Wooster.

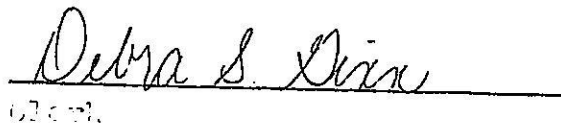
Chief Canter Gave his police report.
