

Hamersville Board of Public Affairs
Regular Meeting
June 25, 1990 - 7:00 p.m.

Present: James Hanselman, Charles Tucker, Eric Mullis

Also present: Joyce Craig, Lynn Dunn, Kay Elliott, Colby Saylor
Mayor Steve Bowyer, and Rose Neal.

President Hanselman called the meeting to order and asked Clerk-Treasurer Craig to read the minutes of the previous meeting. The minutes were approved as read.

President Hanselman asked Mrs. Neal if she would like to address the Board. Mrs. Neal replied that she would. Mrs. Neal asked if the Village would install another street light near her daughter's home on Orchard Street. Her daughter works at night and is fearful of coming home into a darkened area that late. The Board explained that there is sufficient street lights in that area and suggested trimming of the trees would certainly help the lighting. The Board explained that it is the property owner's responsibility to have trees trimmed that are on their property. Lynn Dunn told Mrs. Neal that perhaps she may want to consider renting a light from the Village and have it installed on her own property. Mrs. Neal seemed receptive to this suggestion. She and Lynn will work out the details. Mrs. Neal thanked the Board for their time and left the meeting.

Clerk-Treasurer Craig presented the bills for payment. The bills were approved as presented.

Mr. Tucker said Jim Jewell would like the Board to repair the parking lot that was damaged years ago by water line repair. Mr. Jewell had just recently purchased the property. The Board will view this area in question and decide at a later meeting whether the Village is responsible to make additional repair at this late date.

President Hanselman read letter of resignation from Mrs. Lorena Blanton, effective July 20, 1990. Board accepted resignation.

Lynn Dunn informed the Board that he had removed all poles he wanted from the property where the proposed Village park is to be. Also Lynn requested approval to purchase electrical supplies, totaling \$1,500-\$2,000. Colby Saylor requested permission to purchase miscellaneous supplies for meter reading, etc., not to exceed \$100.00. Tucker moved, Mullis seconded the motion for the above mentioned supplies be approved for purchase. **Motion Carried**

President Hanselman informed the Board the Water line to the proposed park will be installed within the next few days.

There being no further business, Mullis moved to adjourn the meeting, Tucker seconded the motion. **Motion Carried**

President Hanselman adjourned the meeting.
