

ORDINANCE NO. 244

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING PENALTY FOR
UNSANITARY CONDITIONS IN HAMERSVILLE,
OHIO.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of
Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, three-fourths or more of
all members elected thereto concurring, as follows:

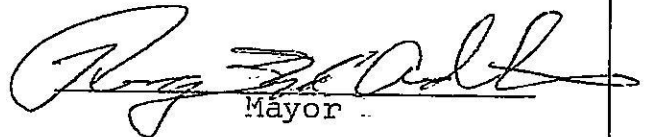
- Section 1. No person being the owner, occupant or person in charge of any premises upon which a privy vault, cesspool or septic tank is located shall permit such vault, pool or tank or any building, fixture or device appurtenant thereto to become foul, noisome, filthy or offensive to neighboring property owners, neighboring residents, or the public in general.
- Section 2. No person being the owner, occupant or person in charge of any premises shall permit any unsanitary drainage or unsanitary pools of water or any stagnant water to exist on their property or to drain off of their property onto any adjoining property.
- Section 3. Any owner, occupant or person in charge of any premises violating Section 1 or Section 2 of this Ordinance shall be given a thirty (30) day written notice by the Police Department of Hamersville, Ohio, to alleviate or rectify said unsanitary condition.
- Section 4. Any owner, occupant or person in charge of any premises after receiving said written notice and not correcting or rectifying said unsanitary condition after the expiration of said thirty (30) day notice shall be violating this Ordinance and shall be subject to a Fine of up to Forty-five

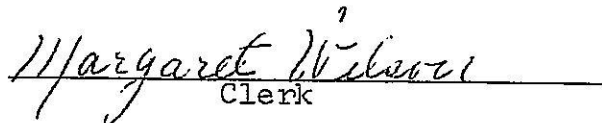
Dollars (\$45.00) for each violation.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, in order to alleviate and rectify unsanitary conditions now existing in said Village and shall be in effect immediately upon its passage.
