## COUNCIL - Special Meeting

April 5, 1991 - 6:30 P.M.

Mayor Bowyer called the meeting to order.

Council again discussed removal of tree limbs and chipping them. Wyndal will bring this subject up at the Board of Public Affairs meeting to see if they have any objections to Mr. Bunton using the chipper.

Parking on Bank Street was discussed again. The Village has to determine where their right-of-way begins and ends. "No Parking" signs will be ordered and installed from Walnut Street to SR 125. Council needs to designate Bank Street as a Fire Lane.

Council again discussed roof repairs. A third quote has been received. This one was from Stutz Bros., the amount was \$5240.00. Following discussion, Stephens moved to award the roof repair job to Stutz, contingent on the BPA paying \$2500.00 of the total amount. Moore seconded the motion. VOTING: Stephens, Moore, Hanes, Hanselman, Staggs NAY: None MOTION CARRIED.

Mayor Bowyer asked Clerk-Treasurer to read the Rules and Regulations for the Officers of the Hamersville Police Department.

Discussion on police department needs was held. Chief Canter said he was concerned at being able to cover the necessary hours over the next few months. Officer Fore is still on disability and Officer Kirkpatrick will be off for a period of time following her upcoming surgery. Officer Riley and Officer Neel said they would work extra hours to cover the off-time of Fore and Kirkpatrick.

Council discussed the possibility of seeking additional millage for an operating levy to cover necessary police expenditures.

Village clean-up day was discussed. Council set May 1, 1991 as Clean-up Day. Hanselman will take care of the notices and Stephens will make arrangements with Rumpke Waste Removal. A second clean-up day was discussed, but no date scheduled at this time.

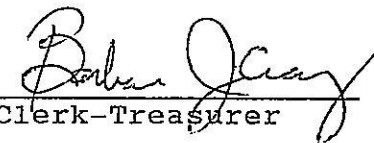
