

RESOLUTION NO. 209
RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THAT THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE,
OHIO, HAS \$149,500.00 AVAILABLE FROM ITS OWN FUNDS
FOR WATER WORKS CONSTRUCTION PURPOSES.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Incorporated Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, three-fourths or more of all members elected thereto concurring as follows:

Section 1. THAT WHEREAS the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, has hereinbefore authorized the sale of \$170,000.00 of Mortgage Revenue Bonds, and whereas the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, has previously collected the sum of \$4535⁰⁰ from connection fees and tap charges from customers of the proposed water works project for the Village of Hamersville, Ohio.

Section 2. NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, now has funds in excess of \$149,500.00 as is required by the Housing and Home Finance Agency, Community Facilities Administration, Accelerated Public Works Program, in order to go forward with Project No. APW-OHIO, 26G, Contract No. H(402)-856.

Section 3. THAT the Clerk of the Village be and she hereby is authorized to send a certified copy of this resolution to the Housing and Home Finance Agency of The Community Facilities Administration by sending the same to Mr. Oliver W. Nelson, Field Engineer, Housing and Home Finance Agency, Room 212, Federal Building, 85 Marconi Boulevard, Columbus 16, Ohio.

Section 4. THAT this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency resolution necessary for the public health and welfare of the residents of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, and more particularly for the furnishing of a safe supply of drinking water and water for fire protection and shall be immediately in effect upon its passage.
