BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS
REGULAR MEETING
NOVEMBER 20, 1995 7:00 P.M.

PRESENT: William Dean Sr. Edward Martin, Martha Hanes-Clerk Treasurer, Steven Bowyer-Mayor, Lynn Dunn Colby Saylor and Kay Elliott.

Also Present: Lee Greeson and Dan Swart from the Tate Monroe Water Company.

Absent: Mack Hanes

William Dean Sr. called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

Mr. Dean introduced Lee Greeson and Dan Swart from the Tate Monroe Water Company who was present to discuss the possibility of a cross connection between Hamersville and Tate Monroe Water Company. The water contract between Hamersville and Georgetown Utilities will be up for renewal in the year 2002 so Hamersville is going to be checking all sources before they have to make a decision on where to go for a new water contract.

Mr. Greeson and Mr. Swart assured the Board that Tate Monroe would be more than willing to work with

Hamersville to obtain a favorable contract since Tate Monroe cannot cross the Clermont-Brown County line. Hamersville now has water almost to the county line.

Mr. Greeson stated that Tate Monroe has a three (3) million gallon capacity and their average pressure is 75 psi. Tate Monroe has a tank on Starling Road and could run additional lines to the county line or Sodom Road to supply Hamersville Water.

Mr. Greeson and Mr. Swart to prepare more detailed information and plans to be brought back to discuss the December 1995 or January 1996 Board meeting.

Mr. Greeson loaned the Board a copy of Tate Monroes Cross Connection Control Program. (Clerk Will Make A Copy for each Board Member)

Martha Hanes reported that she had talked to Paul Rose and the repair project on White Oak Creek is in the planning stages. Rose Construction Company is going to have an outside contractor drill for the placement of the steel plates.

Lynn Dunn reported that the light had been installed on the dump truck.

Mr. Green still needs to take the truck to Bill Dean to have the bolt welded.

Mr. Dunn said that he would be helping Kenny Green install the Village Christmas lights this week end.

Mr. Dunn reported that he had no new information from C.G.E. Co. on the electric line.

The possibility of a new school being built was brought up to Mr. Dunn and he stated that we could service them with electricity by running one line. There were 30 letters sent to persons on the cut off list.

Mr. Saylor reported that he had flushed all but five (5) of the fire hydrant in the village.

Mr. Saylor said he was also able to read the meter on the Georgetown Hill by tapping on it.

Mr. Martin made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. This was seconded by Mr. Dean. Voted and Carried.

Mr. Martin motioned to pay the bills as presented.

This was seconded by Mr. Dean. Voted and carried.

Mayor Bowyer reported that the hold up on full free service or extended service is coming from GTE.

Mr. Dean asked if there was any further business to come before the board; hearing none Mr. Martin

motioned to adjourn seconded by Mr. Dean.

Mr. Dean adjourned the meeting reminding everyone that the next meeting will be December 18, 1995 at 7:00 P.M.
