Regular Village Council Meeting
 February 11, 2008

Mayor Talbott called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status reports, and the January, 2008 Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes, and Mr. K Staggs seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes. All other reports and the Bank Reconciliation were read and approved.

Mr. Shouse seconded the motion, and the motion carried, with all members voting yes, except Mr. W Staggs and Ms. Kirkpatrick, who abstained.

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Don Fore, a former Village Police Officer, passed away recently.

The new Hamersville Postmaster asked if he could put up a sign on the corner, and the Council agreed.

Mr. W Staggs made a motion to waive reading an ordinance three times, and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes. Mr. W Staggs made a motion to raise the electric rates 10%, per the recommendation from the Board of Public Affairs. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

The Clerk Treasurer will have the second phone line taken out of the Chief's house.

Mayor Talbott will contact Mr. Daniels at the State garage about the holes on St. Rt. 125.

Mr. W Staggs made a motion to adjourn, and Mr. Tolliver seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.
