

ORDINANCE #1997- 21

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING EASEMENT
AND PASSED AS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE

WHEREAS, the Village of Hamersville is undergoing a waste water treatment project; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Hamersville has determined it necessary to appropriate certain easements.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THAT:

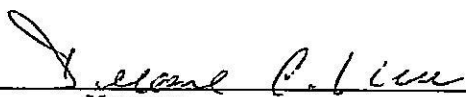
Section 1: An easement in and to the parcel of real estate as described in Exhibit "A" is appropriated for municipal purposes providing a waste water treatment facility (sewer) for the village, pursuant to the constitution and laws of the State of Ohio.

Section 2: This Council finds that the appropriation is necessary for the stated public purpose and that the Village has been unable to agree with the owners of the property.

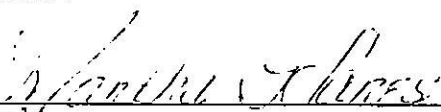
Section 3: The Director of Law is directed to file a complaint for appropriation in a court of competent jurisdiction, to have a jury empaneled to assess the compensation to be paid for the property and is authorized to hire appraisers, title attorneys and negotiators necessary to acquire easements in and over or through the certain parcels of real estate necessary in connection with the sewer project.

Section 4: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as a result that it is necessary to have the easements in place to proceed with the sewer project, the sewer project being on a time schedule necessitating the ordinance being passed as an emergency and for the reason that the public health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, require the immediate issuance of said resolution and the same shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption.
