

VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE
COUNCIL MEETING
October 1, 1990 - 7:00 P.M.

Present: Steve Bowyer, J. R. Elliott, Martha Hanes, Chuck Moore, Wyndal Staggs, Terry Stephens.

Absent: Pat Hanselman

Also present: Joyce Craig, James Canter, George Leicht and Dennie Wooten.

Mayor Bowyer called the meeting to order and asked if there were any additions or corrections to the minutes of the previous meeting. Hanes moved to accept minutes as presented, Moore seconded the motion. **VOTING:** YEA: Hanes, Moore, Elliott, Staggs, Stephens. NAY: None **MOTION CARRIED.**

Mayor Bowyer informed Council that Mr. Robert Neu would like for Brown County Rural Water, the Hamersville Board of Public Affairs and Council to have a joint meeting.

Mayor Bowyer would like for the Street Committee to meet to see what areas need to be corrected by Barrett Paving before we pay the Contractor their retainage.

Mayor Bowyer also informed Council all paperwork for Park Project is now completed, and ready to be finalized. It even appears there will be money left over for playground equipment.

Discussion held again on paying surcharge to Rumpke Waste Removal. Solicitor Leicht has a verbal approval from Mike Ghagin for Village Clerk-Treasurer to go ahead and pay increase but Mr. Leicht suggested we wait until we have something in writing from the Auditor's Office. Since we are talking about a public contract it would be necessary to pass an ordinance for this increase. Solicitor advised Clerk-Treasurer to continue to pay previous monthly rate of \$642.19.

Council again discussed Harper property. Solicitor Leicht said if Council wants to proceed with this they will have to first hire an Engineer to inspect building. If Engineer declares building structurally unsound then Council can proceed to tear down building. Consensus of opinion of Council to hire Engineer to inspect Harper property.

Under new business, Mayor Bowyer brought to Council's attention that the current garbage contract with Rumpke will expire December 31, 1990. Council agreed to advertise for bids for garbage collection. A notice for bids will be put in the News Democrat.

Due to resignation of Mrs. Blanton, it is necessary to hire a back-up for Kay Elliott, Collector. An ordinance was introduced to hire assistant collector. Hanes moved to suspend the rules and read by title only Ordinance 1990-22 to hire Lisa Mullis

for part-time assistant collector at hourly rate of \$3.80. Stephens seconded the motion. **VOTING:** Hanes, Yea; Stephens, Yea; Elliott, Yea; Moore, Yea; Staggs, Yea. **NAY:** None **MOTION CARRIED**

Staggs moved to adopt Ordinance 1990-22 hiring Lisa Mullis as assistant collector. Elliott seconded the motion. **VOTING:** YEA: Staggs, Elliott, Hanes, Moore, Stephens **NAY:** None **MOTION CARRIED**

Council set Wednesday Night, October 31, 6:00-7:30 P.M. as Trick or Treat Night in the Village.

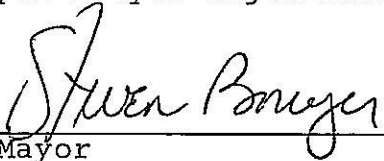
Chief Canter gave his police report for September. Chief Canter said his department needed uniforms plus he needed a jacket for Officer Betty Kirkpatrick.

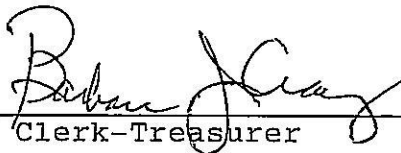
