Regular Village Council Meeting
 March 9, 2009

Present: Mayor Larry Talbott, Wyndal Staggs, Keith Staggs, Betty Kirkpatrick, Michele Watson, Harry Tolliver, Jack Shouse and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.

Also Present: Cecelia Potts, Sam Jewell, Chief Canterand Dennis Schneider.

Mayor Talbott called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status reports, and the February, 2009 Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes, and Ms. Watson seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes. All other reports and the Bank Reconciliation were read and approved.

Brown county 911 is taking down the radio tower at the Sheriff's office. They are asking if the Village knows of any place they can put one in this area.

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Mr. W Staggs made a motion to find an engineer to try for a sidewalk grant. Ms. Watson seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes. The Mayor applied to the State for a 1.4 million dollar issuance.

The Police Department has been having problems with their radios. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adjourn, and Mr. K Staggs seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.
