Jason will get cold patch for the streets.

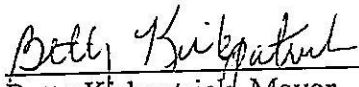

April 11, 2016, cont'd.

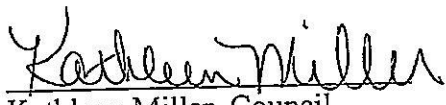

Ms. Watson suggested Council work on job descriptions, policies and codes of conduct for employees. Council agreed.

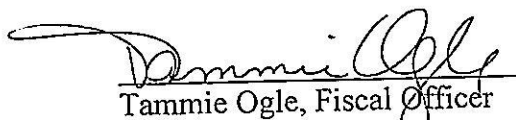
Ms. Budke made a motion to adjourn. Ms. Watson seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.
