Regular Village Council Meeting
March 12, 2001

Present: Mayor Duane C. Neu, Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle, and the following members of the Village Council: Donnie Sowers, Kevin Ogle, Wyndal Staggs, Brien Malicote, Joyce Craig and Bill Dean.
 Also Present: Police Chief Jim Canter, Kay Elliott, Kenny Green, Cecelia Potts, Eunice Ott and Jennifer Hart.

Mayor Neu called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes from the previous meeting. Mr. Ogle made a motion to accept the minutes. Mr. Staggs seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all members voting yes.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the reports, which included the Fund Status, Warrant Register, Expenditure and Revenue Account Status. The Clerk Treasurer then presented all bills as follows:

Mr. Malicote made a motion to pay all bills as presented. Ms. Craig seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all voting yes.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to suspend the rules for reading an ordinance three times, and Mr. Sowers seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes. Mr. Ogle made a motion to pass Ordinance 2001-05 increasing the Court Cost to \$50.00, and terminating the Computer Fund. Mr. Sowers seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all voting yes.

March 12, 2001, cont'd.

Mr. Dean made a motion to apply for two signs from the Ohio Bicentennial Commission. The cost to apply is \$75.00, with the signs being \$1400.00 for the first, and the second for free. Mr. Staggs seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all voting yes.

Mr. Staggs made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2001-06, the Adelphia Franchise. Mr. Dean seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all voting yes. This was the first reading of this Ordinance.

Mayor Neu will attend a HUD meeting in Bethel on March 19th. Mr. Ogle will also attend.

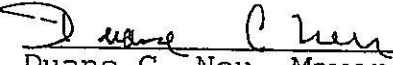
Chief Canter was recognized. We need to do something about the tile in front of the Police Building. It is concrete and has holes. We will have Ronnie Blair take it up and replace it, and widen the culverts on Wooster and Mill. Mr. Staggs complained about a man driving recklessly on Sisterville.

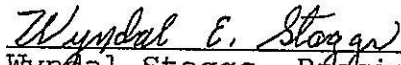
Mr. Green informed the Council that when we had a rainstorm, the sewer readings jumped up 30,000 gallons.

We have some residents asking about culverts. Mr. Dean remarked that the Village should provide labor and the property owner the equipment. There is a man in town who wants to do his front yard and wants us to provide the dirt. The Council answered no. Mr. Staggs asked about Building Codes. Ms. Potts found the appropriate Code in the Building Code Book. There are street signs down on Sisterville and Wayne. We need to get a tar machine.

Mr. Dean made a motion to go into Executive Session, and Mr. Malicote seconded the motion. The motion carried, all voting yes. Mr. Staggs made a motion to leave Executive Session, and Mr. Dean seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes.

Mr. Staggs made a motion to enter an agreement between the Village and Lynn Dunn. The Village will pay Mr. Dunn \$18,000.00 per year, and Mr. Dunn will be on call 24 hours, 7 days a week. The Clerk will deduct \$332.16 per month for the rest of this year to make up for the overpayment he received in 2000. Mr. Sowers seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all members voting yes.

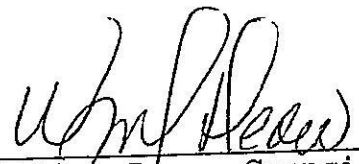

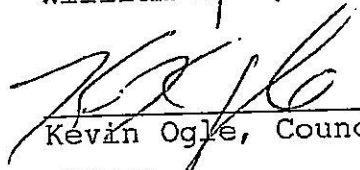

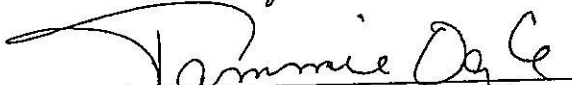
