

ORDINANCE NO. 1483-3

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THEFT OF ELECTRICITY
OR WATER

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville,
Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of all members of Council concurring
as follows:

SECTION 1. No person shall knowingly consume any electricity
or water that has not been correctly registered because a meter,
conduit or attachment of a utility has been tampered with as
defined in Ordinance No. 1483-2 of the Ordinance of the Village
of Hamersville, Ohio, or knowingly use service that has been
disconnected by utility and reconnected without the utility's
consent.

SECTION 2. Whoever violates this Ordinance shall be guilty
of a minor misdemeanor.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation
of the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the
Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio in that it is
necessary to stop the tampering with electric and water meters
and to stop the theft of utility services, and this Ordinance
shall be in immediate effect upon its passage.
