

COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE, OHIO

RESOLUTION NO. 1979-6

DECLARING THE AMOUNT OF TAXES THAT MAY BE RAISED BY LEVY AT THE MAXIMUM RATE AUTHORIZED BY LAW WITHOUT A VOTE OF THE ELECTORS TO BE INSUFFICIENT AND DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF AN ADDITIONAL LEVY IN EXCESS OF SUCH RATE.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, State of Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of all members elected thereto concurring:

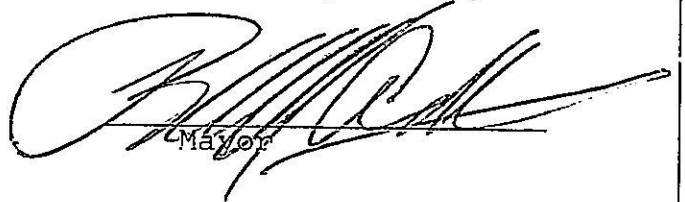
SECTION I. That the amount of taxes that may be raised by the levy of taxes at the maximum rate authorized by RC 5705.02 on the taxable property in said Village will be insufficient to provide adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said Village; and that it is necessary for the purpose of continuing to provide adequate funds for police protection that taxes be levied on the taxable property in said Village for the period of five (5) years at a rate in excess of such maximum rate authorized by said RC 5705.02.

SECTION II. That it is necessary to levy taxes for the years 1981, 1982, 1983, 1984, and 1985 at the rate for each year of 1 mill on each dollar of tax valuation of the taxable property within the Village of Hamersville, Ohio in excess of the rate authorized by said RC 5705.02. This is a renewal levy.

SECTION III. That the Clerk be and she hereby is directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Deputy State Supervisor and Inspector of Elections of Brown County, Ohio, in order that said supervisor and inspector of elections may make the necessary arrangements for the submission of such question to the electors of said Village, as provided by law.

SECTION IV. That the Mayor be and he is hereby directed to cause notice of such election to be posted as required by law.

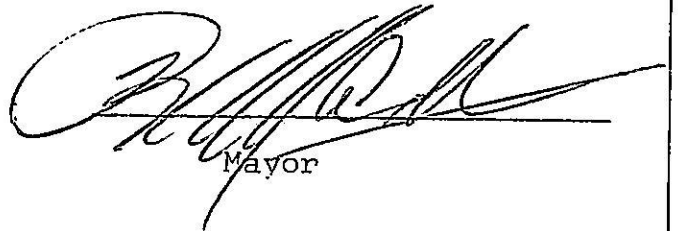

LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a resolution of the Council of the Village of Hamersville passed on the 6th day of August, 1979, there will be submitted to the qualified electors of said village at the general election in the Village of Hamersville on the 6th day of November, 1979, the question of renewing a levy for taxes for the years 1981, 1982, 1983, 1984 and 1985, at the rate for each year of 1.00 mill on each dollar of the valuation of the taxable property within the Village of Hamersville in excess of the rate authorized by RC 5705.02 for the purpose of providing funds for police protection.

Those who vote in favor of such renewal tax levy will have written or printed on their ballots "For the tax levy" and those who vote against such renewal tax levy will have written or printed on their ballots, "against the tax levy".
