

Hamersville Village
Special Session
Council - Board of Public Affairs
May 17, 1990 - 7:00 p.m.

Present were: J.R. Elliott, Patrick Hanselman, Terry Stephens, Wyndal Staggs, James Hanselman, Eric Mullis, Charles Tucker and Steve Bowyer.

Also present were: Joyce Craig, John Van Harlingen

Mayor Bowyer called the meeting to order and stated the purpose of our meeting was to discuss Issue 2 and the Park Project.

Mayor Bowyer turned the meeting over to John Van Harlingen.

Mr. Van Harlingen said the deadline for requests for Issue 2 money had been moved from sometime in the Fall to the middle of July. Quite a lot of work has to be done if Village is going to apply. We can apply for money each year. However, a 5-year plan does have to be written.

The Village has to provide 10% of whatever amount we request from Issue 2 monies. Money could possibly be awarded by end of December 1990.

Council would like to apply for money to repair or redo more Village streets. Board of Public Affairs would like to request money to replace water line on Liming Lake Road plus have 6-8 valves as well as fire hydrants replaced.

Mr. Van Harlingen said everything would have to be typed in a certain format before presentation. He offered to work with us whenever we had all information together. He took drawings of water lines and left the meeting.

Park Project was discussed again. We need to have 3 bids on everything, picnic tables, benches, sidewalks, etc., before projects can proceed.

Discussion was held on obtaining right-of-way from Mr. Canter for installing sidewalk and water line. We will have our Solicitor prepare a Letter of Agreement with Mr. Canter.

Garage Doors for Village Garage was discussed. President asked Council for permission to use Dennie Wooten, Street Commissioner, in repairing doors. Council agreed that Mr. Wooten could work for Board of Public Affairs but they would have to pay him his regular rate of pay.

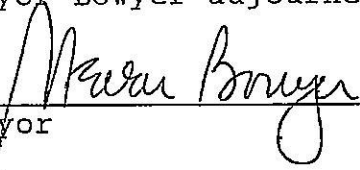
J.R. Elliott brought up the subject of "Clean-Up" Day for the Village of Hamersville. Terry Stephens will contact Rumpke to schedule two days in consecutive weeks to have extra help and trucks available. We will discuss at next regular Council meeting.

Mr. Staggs informed Council that he checked out the parking problem at the Auction Barn. Mr. Staggs said if we install "No Parking from here to Corner" signs at each corner of that intersection, we would have to do it at every intersection or we would be discriminating. Mr. Staggs suggested perhaps extending the yellow lines that are already there about 10 more feet would help the problem.

Council agreed to just extend yellow lines 10 more feet on all four corners of intersection.

There being no further business, J.R. Elliott made motion to adjourn the meeting. Patrick Hanselman seconded the motion.
