RECONVIENED COUNCIL MEETING
December 29, 1994 - 7:00P.M.**

Mayor Steve Bowyer called meeting to order at 7:05P.M. Mayor Bowyer met with Brandstetter to discuss sewer project. Cost was based on 10,000 gallons of water per household when residents in reality use only around 5,000 gallons per month. This fact will help to bring sewer rates down to a more realistic cost for the Village of Hamersville residents. Also what Georgetown will charge the village for processing. Brandstetter would like to meet with Council to discuss an updated sewer plan.

Neu mentioned he had talked with the security people and the system was available to be put in. It was decided the security system would be put in place after the back door is repaired which will be done by DeCoursey, January 9, 1995.
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Neu motioned for council to go ahead and buy the security system then collect the monies owed from water and electric. Hanes seconded the motion. **VOTING: YEA:** Neu, Sowers, Staggs, Hanes, ~~Mayor Bowyer~~. **NAY:** Nester. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Hanes moved to pay bills. Staggs seconded the motion. **VOTING: YEA:** Nester, Neu, Sowers, Staggs, Mayor Bowyer, Hanes. **NAY:** None. **MOTION CARRIED.**
